

## Stacy's PTA Meeting Notes for Tuesday, 1/16/18

1. Call to order at 2:10. Present for PTA meeting: Tracy Jennings, Stacy Stavro, Kim Johnson, Melissa Brennan, Cassie Woolgar, Principle Mrs. Nichole Basl, and Teacher on Assignment Dr. Tina Craig.
2. Approval of last meeting's minutes (11/28)- Kim Johnson, 2<sup>nd</sup> Cassie Woolgar.
3. Stacy and Melissa reconciled bank statements from July-October 2017.
4. Melissa went over the budget- \$16,000 has been spent on software for the school leaving about \$4000 in the account once all of the checks clear. A check from Box Tops for Education was received for \$2066.80 and a check from Fry's Food for \$552.83.
5. Father/Daughter Dance (Feb 2<sup>nd</sup>)- Theme chosen unanimously is Sock Hop. We will serve light desserts/snacks, fruits, veggies, and refreshments (water, fruit punch & root beer floats). Changed time to 6pm-8pm, Cost will be \$25 for one adult and up to 3 children, additional adult \$10, and additional children \$5. Tracy has a link set up through Wufoo for parents to register ahead of time, but tickets will also be sold at the door. Kim will create a sign-up genius for volunteers, set up should start by 5pm. Tonya Brock will work on flyers and we will have them distributed to teachers by Thursday.
6. Read-a-thon (March 2<sup>nd</sup>)- Kim and Tracy will work on condensing the student packet used last year. It will be specified what the money raised will be used for: 1 to 1 Chromebooks and iPads in each classroom and to expand STEAM technology. Tonya Brock is working on a K-6 Reading Pathway worksheet for each student to complete during Read-a-thon. Alex is working on getting prizes and gift cards from businesses. Tracy found silicon bracelets that can be used as prizes for every 'Legendary Reader'. Tracy has also created a Wufoo link for donors to use. Mrs. Basl suggested having Otter Pop Party for the classrooms in which all students complete and turn in the pathway worksheet. Rose suggested someone in character visit classrooms once a week with prizes and Dr. Seuss trivia.
7. Fun Fest (March 16<sup>th</sup>)- Rides/games/inflatables are all booked. Kim will email Jennifer Yenerich about reaching out to the high schools for volunteers. Separate meeting is set up with Rose and Jane for next Tuesday, January 23.
8. Mother/Son Bowling (April 14<sup>th</sup>)- We have a \$1200 credit with the bowling alley that needs to be used. This credit goes towards bowling and shoes only. Kim will contact the bowling alley to reserve location, date, and lanes. \$12/person will include 1.5 hours of bowling, shoe rental, 1 slice of cheese pizza and drink.
9. A unanimous vote was taken in favor of reimbursing the school for the purchase of the Memorial Bench for Declan Presmyck in the amount of \$778.12.
10. Flagpole Jan 26<sup>th</sup>- Kim will make announcements to include advertising for the Father/Daughter Dance, Read-a-thon, and Box tops leader for second semester.
